

Implementation Rules for Students of Kainan University to Study Double Major in the Department of Health Industry Management

Article 1

These regulations are formulated in accordance with Article 4 of the Degree Awarding Law, Article 28 of the University Law, and Article 8 of the Regulations on Double Majors for Students of Each Department of the University.

Article 2

Students from all departments of our school who have taken more than 16 credits per semester in the previous academic year and have an average score of 75 points can apply from the second academic year to the first semester of the highest grade of study (excluding extension of years of study) Add this department to make it a double major.

Article 3

Those who apply for additional majors in this department are double majors, and those who have not completed their selection for one year are not allowed to withdraw or transfer to a minor department.

Article 4

Students pursuing double majors in this department must, in addition to completing all required courses and credits for majors in this department, students from other colleges must take at least nine additional credits in elective subjects before they can obtain the qualification for double majors in this department.

Article 5

The above-mentioned compulsory subject specifications are based on the regulations for the academic year of the year when the department is double majoring.

Article 6

Students studying double majors in this department, if the original department courses are similar to the courses specified by the department and have the same number of credits, may apply for credit credits, and will be granted exemption after approval by the department's curriculum committee.

Article 7

Students studying double majors in this department must comply with the course requirements for students in this department during their studies in this department.

Article 8

Students studying double majors in this department may take courses in their original department if the required courses in their original department are the same as those stipulated by this department. Otherwise, they should take courses in this department.

Article 9

Other matters not stipulated in these regulations shall be handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the school department °

Article 10

These regulations shall be implemented after being approved by the departmental affairs meeting, submitted to the academic affairs meeting for approval, and shall be implemented after being approved by the academic affairs meeting. The same applies to amendments °
